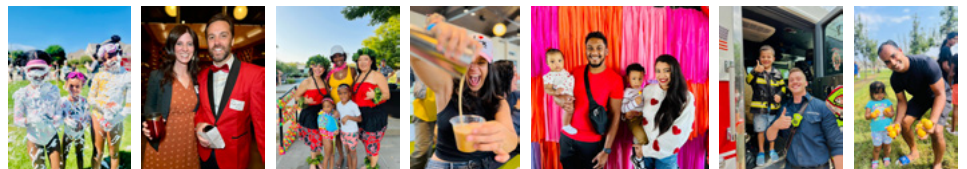
## PURPLE HEART Ceremony
